



Seder Guest Fingerprint Tree

Here's an activity that can create a keepsake for Passover by providing a record of who attended your seder while giving your guests the opportunity to begin to reflect on the process of liberation from the moment they arrive at your doorstep.

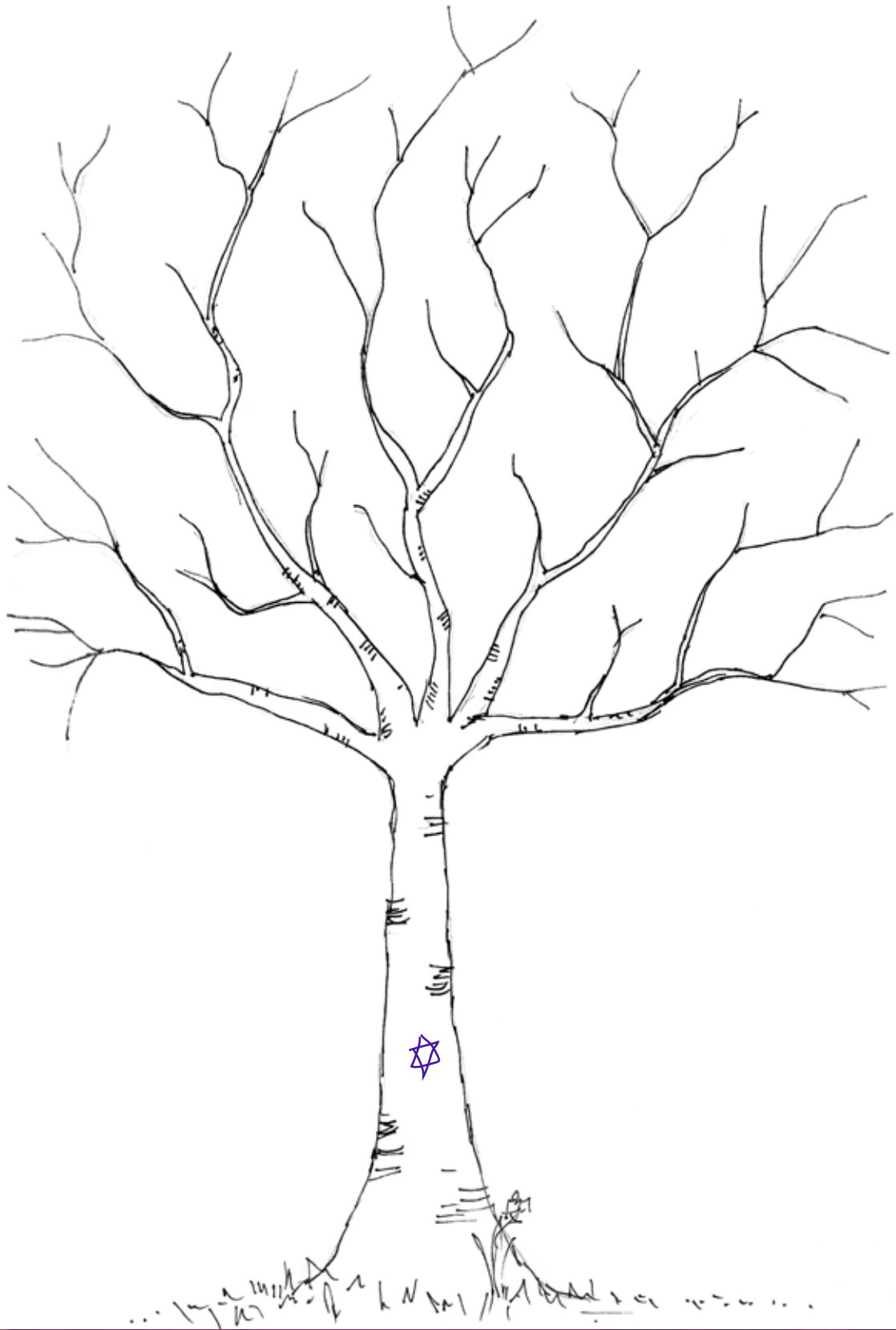
What You Will Need:

- Printed template of the tree
- At least 2 different colored ink pads
- Fine tip ink pen
- Baby wipes

Instructions:

1. Download the tree artwork and print it out on paper.
 2. Have guests place their **FIRST** fingerprint as a leaf on the tree.
 3. Have them write their name next to their fingerprint-leaf.
 4. Have guests consider one of these two questions:
 - a. Whose story of liberation inspires you this year?
 - b. Whose liberation are you hoping for this year?
 5. Have guests place their **SECOND** fingerprint using a different color ink.
 6. If guests are comfortable, have them write the name of the person that either inspires them or that they are thinking about this year next to the second fingerprint-leaf.
- Tip: Display the tree at your seder table. Use it at your seder as an ice-breaker. Store it with your other Passover materials to bring out at next year's seder.
